



when you PLAY

As you play with pretend figures, talk about superheroes and the powers they have. Explain that those powers are pretend, but God's power is real. And His power is greater than anyone or anybody. Ask your child about ways they have heard about God's power in stories of Moses this month.

when you DRIVE



Take advantage of the time in the car to sing some praise songs this month. Listen to a Christian radio station, or play other music your family enjoys. Teach your child that we honor God and give praise to Him because we know he is the greatest God!

when you RELAX



As you prepare for bedtime, talk about ways that you saw God's power that day — in the sunset, in the stars that come out at night, in the fall leaves changing colors. Praise God for His power when you pray.

PARENT TIME



Last week we learned about baby Moses in the basket, and this month we continue learning about him, all the way to his victorious exodus with the Israelites from Egypt. Throughout Moses's story, God shows His power and His love for His people. When the Israelites wondered if God had forgotten them, He moved powerfully to rescue them. You can extend these concepts at home by teaching your child to rely on God's power, and praise Him for being the one true God. I pray that you are encouraged by remembering that God is *still* working for His people. Whatever you're facing, He sees you and cares about your family!
